BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 10th day of July, A.D. 2017 the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in regular session at 3:30 PM with KATHYRN G. WISEMAN, County Judge as the Presiding Officer. JIMMIE LONG, Commissioner Precinct No. 3 was absent.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve purchase request for the Volunteer Fire Department – 6 firefighters to attend school to TEEX Extension Service at a cost of \$5430.00. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, discussed a proposed pipeline along Midway and Val Verde Roads. He will turn it over to Josh Hamby, County Attorney, to complete the paperwork.

Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, advised court he would be attending infrastructure training in Lubbock on September 8 & 9, 2017. He extended the invitation to Commissioners. Registration deadline is August 1, 2017.
