BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 28th day of October, A.D. 2024 the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in Workshop @ 9:00 AM and Regular Session at 10:00 AM with RANDY JOHNSON, County Judge as the Presiding Officer. The following members were present: EDDILISA RAY, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, CASH BERRY, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, JIMMIE LONG, Commissioner Precinct No. 3 and DOUG WAGNER, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

The Workshop was called to order @ 9:00 AM.

The meeting started with Itzel Gomez, Judge's Secretary, showing a few pictures and a short clip of the Alamo Plaque Ceremony.

The Court then discussed the Financial requirements for certain agencies that receive donations from the County. The following requirements were set for agencies receiving \$5000 or more:

- Require to present an Annual Profit / Loss statement plus a projection for the current/following year.
- Minutes showing Financials are being accepted by their individual Boards.
- Invite each entity to visit the Commissioner's Court to share what their organization does and why the County should keep investing in them.

These were decided upon by the Court and no vote was necessary.

The Interlocal Agreement between Howard County, Martin County, and Sterling County to Reimburse the Salary of the DPS Secretary was returned signed by the other Counties. Judge Johnson is now signing the Agreement and filing. It was approved at a previous meeting of the Court.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Wagner to move forward with Komatsu Architecture Fee Proposal on Library renovations as presented by Judge Johnson. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Ray and seconded by Judge Johnson to approve a Contract for Architectural Services with Burns Architecture, LLC for Dispatch with the understanding that Lindsay Wilkerson, County Attorney, will be able to add verbiage to the contract that is required for the County to do business with private companies. The contract was sent to and presented by Judge Johnson. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Wagner to accept the Treasurer's Monthly Report for September 2024 as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Berry and seconded by Commissioner Ray to accept the Treasurer's Quarterly Report for quarter ending September 30, 2024 as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Jackie Olson, County Auditor, gave a Recap of JP Collections for 2001-2024 for information purposes only. No action needed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Ray and seconded by Commissioner Berry to accept donations to the Howard County Sheriff's Office as follows: Broughton Foundation Trust in the amount of \$110,000 and Pioneer Natural Resources \$10,000 as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Ray and seconded by Commissioner Berry to approve the Invoices as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Berry to approve the Purchase Requests as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor.
