

# NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.714466 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Irion County.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.714466 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.770370 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.715093 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2021 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Irion County from the same properties in both the 2020 tax year and the 2021 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Irion County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Irion County is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2021 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 24, 2021 AT 9:00 am AT Irion County Commissioners Court.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Irion County is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Irion County Commissioners' Court of Irion County at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED  
AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Irion County last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Irion County this year.

<b>Total tax levy on all properties</b>	\$8,910,854	\$8,277,957	decrease of -632,897, or -7.10%
